8/11 day is a great reminder for all of us to always call 811 before any digging project. Make sure to call three working days in advance of your digging project. Information you will need to provide if calling in a project or filing online includes:

### Contact Information

1. Your name, phone & email
2. Address, street, city, state zip code
3. Field contact & phone number

### Dig Site Physical Location

1. The city, township, or village your work will take place
2. The address of your dig site
3. The side of the street your dig site is on and the nearest intersecting road

### Dig Site Information

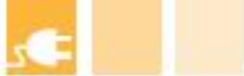
1. Start date
2. Work type
3. Explosives, equipment & pre-marking
4. Marking instructions
5. Remarks



Shifting non-essential electricity use to before 11 a.m. or after 7 p.m. June through August—when the price of electricity is at its highest—helps us keep energy costs low. Every little step helps:

- Run your dishwasher in the early morning or overnight.
- Open your dishwasher after the rinse cycle is complete to let dishes air dry.
- Only run your dishwasher when it's full.
